Plan your trips by doing all your errands at once. This can reduce fuel consumption and toxic emissions.



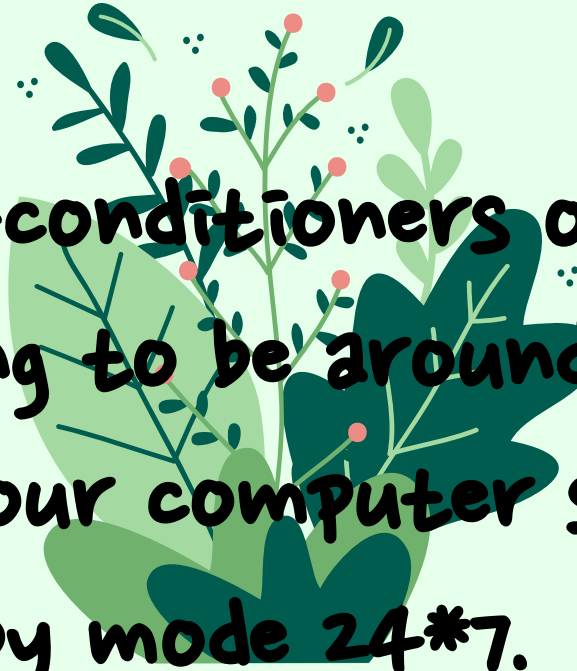


Is there another way to get there?
